Check list:Photo of the foot or shell.
Both the outer and inner edges of the sheil contour must be visible. The camera lens must be perpendicular to the pyramid.


4 photos, as shom in the images above. The camera must be placed perpendicular to the legs, in a low position, and both legs must be centered on the phato. Please remember that all prosthetic components must be completely visible, including the socket. Please remove shoes, sooks and any object that covers the prosthesis.

- In the factory state, the lower part of the cover is flat.
- In the case of the foot as shown in the picture, the lower part of the cover can be ground to the shape of the foot
